- 1. All Open Division Livestock Rules apply.
- 2. The Shows will be Junior & Senior Doe Shows sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association (ADGA). Their rules shall govern, provided they do not conflict with any rules and regulations of the Douglas County Fair Board.
- 3. **Fees:** \$3.00 per animal.
- 4. **Entries must be received no later than July 23rd, 2021**. Late entries are at the discretion of the Barn Superintendent.
- 5. Animals will be accepted for entry 4:00 pm Monday, July 28th through Tuesday, July 29th 7:45 am. Animals must be removed form the fairgrounds at the end of the show.
- 6. There will be no pen fees for the show, but exhibitors must provide their own bedding and clean out their pens before leaving the fairgrounds. The pens will be used by the fair the following weekend.
- 7. Health Rules: a. All goats must have a valid Scrapie tag or ID through a program that provides the same type of identification as the Scrapie Eradication Program. Any animal with any sign of abscess, swelling or inflammation or any other health concern will be dismissed from the Fairgrounds and must be taken home.
- 8. All animals must be registered with the American Dairy Goat Association (ADGA). Ownership must be established in the herd registration. Papers must be verified and approved by the Barn Superintendent before the animal is accepted for exhibit. Failure to comply with this rule will disqualify the animal.
- 9. Entries may be limited. When we receive entries and reach the maximum number of people allowed to attend, we will not be able to accept anymore entries.
- 10. We may require all people attending to wear a mask or face covering anytime you are within 6 feet of anyone not in your party. MASKS MAY BE REQUIRED IN THE SHOW RING. If you do not comply, you may be asked to leave the Goat Barn.
- 11. Base date for an animal's age is the day of judging.
- 12. Show order is subject to change based on number of animals entered.
- 13. ADGA RULES SHALL GOVERN.
