ENTRIES: Please submit entry form (fillable PDF) electronically or by mail, addresses on form. Payment can be made by check or PayPal (RDGAtreasurer@gmail.com), Credit/Debit Cards will be accepted at the entry table. Substitutions allowed. The gates will be open for entries at 4:00pm on Monday. Animals must be entered by Tuesday, July 27th at 7:45 AM.

ENTRY FEE: \$9.00 per animal. All animals shown must pay an entry fee. No refunds of entry fees, but substitutions will be allowed. Please use email or mail to submit the attached entry form. (Note that combined with the Douglas County Fair show, this works out to \$6 per animal per ring.)

PEN FEES: There will be no pen fees for the show, but exhibitors **MUST** provide their own bedding and clean out their pens before leaving the fairgrounds.

The fairgrounds has pens with vertical slats. IT IS VERY EASY FOR JR DOES, ESPECIALLY NIGERIANS TO ESCAPE THESE PENS! If you will be bringing jr does, PLEASE bring a way to contain them. THE CONTAINMENT AND SAFETY OF YOUR ANIMALS IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.

All animals and belongings must be removed from the barn expeditiously after the show on TUESDAY, July 27th.

CAMPING: **CAMPING IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE BARN OR IN THE FAIRGROUNDS.** You may be able to reserve a space in the Fair RV Park with water and electrical hookups—contact the Fair office at (541) 957-7010, or go to the Douglas County (OR) Fairgrounds RV Park Website, http://www.douglasfairgrounds.com/rvpark.html. LIGHTING: Building lights will be turned off at midnight; please bring headlamp/flashlight if you will need lighting to check your goats.

VEHICLE GATES: Close at midnight Monday and re-open at 6:00 am Tuesday morning. You may enter walk-in gates during that time but you will not be able to bring your vehicle in or take it out.

- THETIMES LISTED ARE NOT PRECISE—THE ORDER OF THE SHOW IS SUBJECT TO CHANGETO FACILITATE TIMING. Schedule changes prior to the date of the show will be posted on our Facebook page and the District VII discussion group.
- All goats must be registered/recorded with American Dairy Goat Association.
- Original registration certificate or stamped duplicate is required for all dairy goats
- Base Date for computing age shall be July 27.
- There will be no pre-show milk out. Animals with overly-distended udders will be discriminated against.
- Judges will ROTATE and the animals will show in the same ring.
- OFFICIAL ADGA SHOWS ----ADGA rules shall govern.

COVID restrictions to follow facility guidelines will apply. Be prepared to mask and distance. Policy is subject to change, please look at our FB page for updates. Refunds will NOT be offered if you refuse to follow policy. Refunds WILL be made if show is cancelled.
